Nolan has produced over 100 wildlife and hunting based videos. The primary topic he features is White-tailed Deer and wildlife conservation. His productions have been broadcast worldwide on ABC, CBS, NBC and BBC. He has sold over 2 million videos and won national and international awards for his work.

A professional storyteller, Wade has spent considerable time in both the Arctic and in Africa and has gathered true life and death stories that he shares in his speaking events.
